

# Pre-Boarding Checklist



- Pet(s) are up to date on all required vaccines**
  - Rabies
  - Distemper (DHLPP or DHPP with Leptospirosis vaccine)
  - Bordetella
  - Canine Influenza (H3N2 or H3N8)
- Pet(s) have been treated with flea and heartworm prevention**
  - Negative fecal test result from the last 6 months
- Confirmed pick-up and drop-off times**
- Confirm add-on service(s), such as grooming, kongs, enrichment, training or Premium Lodging**
- Pre-package and label food for meals**
  - Include extra meals in case of extended stay (Pre-bagged meals are excluded for >1 week stays)
  - Packed a supply of any supplemental foods (wet food, meat/veggies, broth, etc.) needed to help for picky eaters
- Refill and label any medications needed during their stay**
  - Packed a supply of whatever treat/food is used to administer medicine (pill pockets, cheese, lunchmeat, etc.)
- Provide updated contact information, emergency contacts and veterinarian information**

## Helpful Tips

- Do not pack your luggage in front of your pet.
- Be calm and confident leading up to and at drop-off. Keeping this experience familiar and short helps limit anxiety. Your pet will miss you as much as you miss them but if you are comfortable and consistent with their routine, they will have a positive transition.
- Arrange for an earlier drop-off so your pet has time to acclimate and exercise before bedtime.
